Numeracy:

- We will be using bar modelling to help us to understand and solve word problems. Problems will cover number, fractions and measure.
- We will be working practically in order to investigate length, weight and capacity.
- We will continue to work on the 4 rules to improve our accuracy.
- We will investigate properties of 2D and 3D shape.

Science:

The children will learn about light, Earth, space and sound. Plants and living things and their environment.



ICT: We will be starting our new exciting coding programme where the children will learn how to write their own algorithms and create their own apps.

Understanding the Bible and develop an awareness of how it developed. Identify different ways of praying and exploring why people pray.

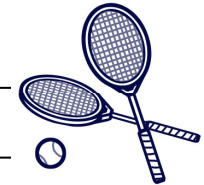
