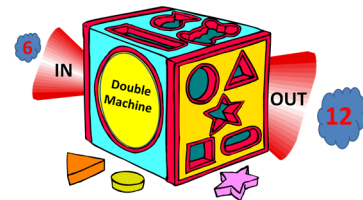
LET IT SNOW!

Maths this week has focussed on doubling numbers using a special doubling machine. If you've got a set of dominoes at home, these are great for helping the children to spot and count doubles.

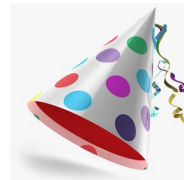


3D Shapes Song
