Our Geography topic is all about Maps and Where We Live. These are some activities you could try:

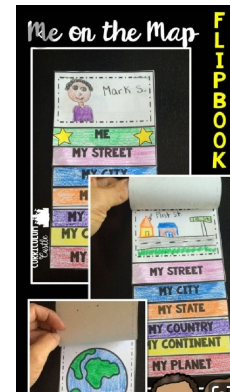


- Make a map of your bedroom, house, street, village.
