## Weekly Safeguarding Update – YouTube TV app is rolling out "Parent Code" for enhanced child safety.



YouTube's new "parent code" feature helps parents control their kids' viewing on smart TVs. This four-digit PIN ensures children can only access appropriate content by requiring the code to:

Watch YouTube when signed out. Switch to older family members' accounts (13+). Remove accounts from the TV app.9



With YouTube phasing out the Kids app on smart TVs, this feature adds extra protection, addressing concerns about children encountering unsuitable content. Once available you can set it up by going to the YouTube TV app's "Settings" menu and select "Parent code." The feature started to be rolled out from mid – December.
