Weekly Safeguarding Update - Impact of screen time on sleep.

Impact of screen time on sleep

Screen use, especially in the evening, is associated with delayed bedtimes and poorer quality sleep. The interactive nature of many apps and games keeps children awake longer than intended, pushing bedtime later into the night. Social media platforms, in particular, with their constant stream of updates and notifications, can pull kids into a cycle of endless scrolling.

Keeping devices out of bedrooms is also likely to significantly reduce the chance of your child accessing inappropriate or harmful content or people online.

Having a clear rule in place for when devices shut off and where they are stored overnight can help both sleep quality and safety
