Good afternoon

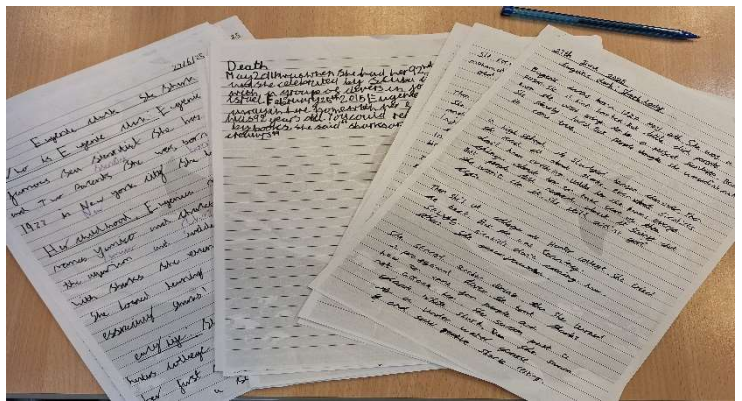
It has been another amazing week here at Masham Primary School and please read below to see what amazing learning and events have been happening across school.
