#### Good afternoon

#### Parent Forum.

This week, school has received the Ofsted feedback letter following the monitoring visit in January 2025. The letter following the visit has been sent out this afternoon. Therefore, I would like to invite all parents and carers to school on Tuesday 18th March, at 6:30pm, to a parent forum. In this forum I will discuss the outcome of the letter and the improvements that have been identified since the last Ofsted inspection in January 2024.

The feedback is extremely positive and highlights the rapid school improvement that is being made. It is important to state, that because this was a monitoring visit and not a full inspection, the current Ofsted judgment of the school cannot be changed. The main aim of the parent forum is to explain the criteria that school is graded against and what the next steps are for the school moving forward.
