Weekly Safeguarding Update - Meta Al

WhatsApp has installed a new Al feature

If your child has access to WhatsApp it's important to know that new feature has quietly appeared on WhatsApp: a built-in chatbot called Meta Al.



Key things to be aware of and talk to your child about:

- Meta is on the other end of every conversation with the AI not a real friend or a private chat. Without clear understanding, they might disclose personal details, feelings, or information about friends and family, which could stay within Meta's systems.
- All messages sent to Meta Al may be stored and used by Meta. This means anything your child shares could be kept, analysed, and even used to train the Al further.
- Meta advises users not to share personal, sensitive, or private information about themselves or others — when using the Al.
- Remind them: if you wouldn't want it written on a public wall, don't send it to an Al.
- Regularly check WhatsApp settings and updates, as new privacy options may become available.
